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// HOW TO TAKE ONLINE VOTING //

GAMUT's online voting feature will enable the board secretary to open up online voting on any specific agenda item. Once opened, a new screen will pop up on each board member's computer asking for their vote. Once the votes have been cast, the secretary can close the votes and display the results. The secretary can always manually record a vote if a member was on a conference call and not on their computer.

- 1) Click on an agenda item
- 2) Click on Minutes tab
- 3) Click on Record Votes

Admins will need to record who made the motion and who seconded the motion.

- 6) When all votes are cast, click on Close Voting Note: If a board member still has their voting window open, a message will display that voting is closed
- 7) Optional: The voting results can be displayed to voting members. Click on Share Results to have the results pop-up on board members screen.
